SPECIAL TOWN MEETING: OCTOBER 15, 2012

To any of the Constables of the Town of Gill in the County of Franklin,

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Gill Town Hall in said Town on Monday, the Fifteenth day of October, in the year Two Thousand and Twelve (10/15/2012) at 6:00 p.m. in the evening then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to establish a revolving fund for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2013 in accordance with MGL Chapter 44 Section 53E½ for the receipts related to the Town's recycling program and expenditures for the operation of the Town's solid waste and recycling programs, membership in and services of the Franklin County Solid Waste Management District, and the purchase of recycled content or environmentally preferable products, to be under the authority of the Board of Selectmen and not to exceed \$10,000 in expenditures in FY13, with all money remaining in the fund at the end of the fiscal year, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to amend or rescind the vote taken under Article 11 (Energy Bond and Siemens annual fee) at the Annual Town Meeting on June 19, 2012, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 3: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate by taxation, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide a sum or sums of money to pay into the General Obligation Energy Conservation Bond Sinking Fund, and to pay supplemental interest associated with said bond, both relating to the energy project at the Gill Elementary School, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 4: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate by taxation, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide \$90.00 (Ninety and 00/100 Dollars) to fully fund the 3% cost of living adjustment (COLA) for the Tax Collector, Town Clerk, and Treasurer, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 5: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate by taxation, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to supplement the Fiscal Year 2013 operating budget for Tree & Forestry Expenses, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 6: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate by taxation, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to increase the public hours of the Slate Memorial Library, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 7: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate by taxation, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to supplement the Fiscal Year 2013 operating budget for the Slate Memorial Library, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 8: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate by taxation, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to supplement the Fiscal Year 2013 operating budget for the Cemetery Commission, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 9: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate by taxation, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for one or more of the Stabilization Funds of the Town, or take any action relative thereto. (A 2/3 majority is required to place money into a stabilization fund.)

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town Hall, Main Road; Post Office, Mt. Hermon; The Gill Store & Tavern, Main Road; and Riverside Municipal Building, Route 2, in said Town fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as foresaid.
