## What is the Next Step for the Great Falls Battlefield Project?

to an Educational Presentation about Phase II of  
the Great Falls Battlefield Project.

**Tuesday October 27, 2015, 7–8:30 p. m.**  
**Riverside Municipal Building**

- GHC members and other project partners will describe the PHASE II grant application currently being prepared for submission to the National Park Service.
- The grant, from the National Park Service American Battlefield Protection Program, seeks to discover and protect sites in Riverside and elsewhere in Franklin County for the May 19, 1676 colonial-native engagement during King Philip's War. Phase I of the grant was primarily research. Phase II will attempt to identify battlefield sites and obtain physical evidence through archaeological investigations.
- Landowners in the key project areas are invited to support Phase II research by agreeing to allow researchers to survey their properties. Granting survey permission is a totally voluntary decision and will help support a thorough investigation and better understanding and appreciation of this major historical episode.
