

# Scarecrows on the Common



For the first time, the Gill Recreation Committee is hosting a Scarecrows on the Common display. We hope that you will help us fill the Gill Common with scarecrows! Feel free to take a stroll through the Common to view all the wonderful creations!

A few things to know:

Open to all ages, individuals, families, clubs, groups and businesses.

Scarecrows can be traditional, whimsical, fairytale, humorous, storybook and beyond. Let your imagination run wild! Just remember this is a family friendly display, and any inappropriate scarecrows will be removed from the display.

FREE entry! No cost to display your creation on the Gill Town Common.

Scarecrows should be durable to withstand wind, rain and sun. Please bring a post to display your scarecrow and rope if it will need to be secured to post or ground. Make sure to place a small sign with your name/business so we know who made the scarecrow. We will not be responsible for any loss or damage to scarecrows on display.

No electricity is provided, but solar, wind or battery power is allowed.

You may set up your scarecrow starting on October 10<sup>th</sup>. Scarecrows MAY NOT be attached to utility poles, support cables, flag pole or solar lights.

Scarecrows must remain on display until October 31<sup>st</sup>. You are responsible for removing your scarecrow by Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>.
