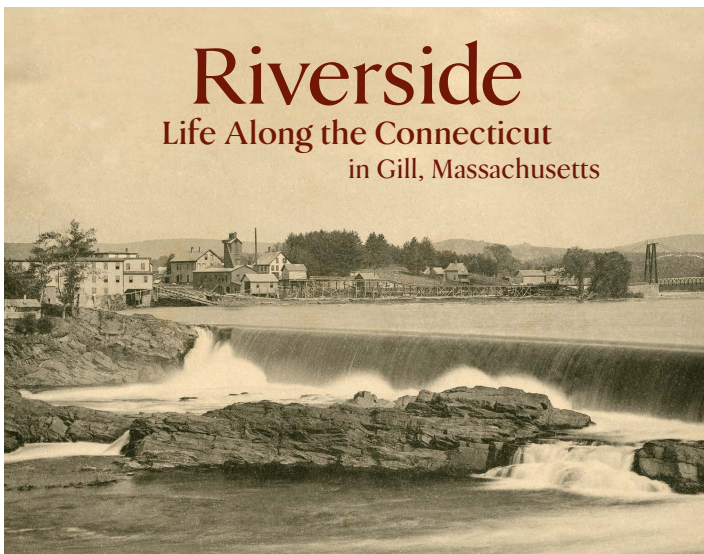


Riverside: an Important Book

THE GEOLOGY OF RIVERSIDE: The Lily Pond Barrier, a mini-Niagara Falls; the Eastern Border Fault; the discovery of armored mudballs.

RIVERSIDE DINOSAUR FOOTPRINTS: The discovery and commercialization of "bird" tracks by Gill residents Roswell Field and Timothy M. Stoughton.

THE NATIVE AMERICAN STORY: Fishing at the Falls, archaeological evidence, the Battle of Great Falls.

SETTLEMENT OF RIVERSIDE: The first Gill tavern, agricultural experiments, the rise of the farmer-politician, the Gill diaries.

RIVER TRAFFIC: Ferries, flatboats, and steamboats, early dams on the Falls, building bridges, early water power.

RIVERSIDE INDUSTRIES: The era of the huge log drives, the Turners Falls Lumber Co., and New England Fibre Co.

VILLAGE LIFE IN THE 19TH AND 20TH CENTURIES: Immigrant factory workers, a planned community, schools and businesses, social life, and the architecture of Riverside homes.
